People v. Terrion Liggins 2022-CF-619

Gun-Toting Crack Dealer Sentenced to Prison

On March 8, 2024, Terrion Liggins (DOB 12/30/1987), formerly of Danville, Illinois, pleaded guilty to Possession of a Controlled Substance with Intent to Deliver, a Class 1 felony, for 10 years Illinois Department of Corrections and to Unlawful Possession of a Weapon by a Felon, a Class 2 felony, for 8 years in the Illinois Department of Corrections. Sentences are to run concurrently and will be followed by 1 year mandatory supervised release.

Judge Derek Girton heard evidence that on December 6, 2022, agents with the Vermilion County Metropolitan Enforcement Group executed a search warrant on the home of Terrion Liggins and located 28 grams of crack cocaine. Agents also located firearm ammunition, which Liggins is not legally allowed to possess due to prior felony convictions. Liggins admitted to agents that he sold crack cocaine to support his lifestyle.

State's Attorney Jacqueline Lacy expressed her gratitude to the agents of the Vermilion County Metropolitan Enforcement Group for their efforts to remove illegal drugs from the streets of Vermilion County.
