The Danville Election Commission must appoint a panel of 5 election judges to serve in each city precinct for every election. We are currently looking for voters to serve in this capacity for a two year term.

An election judge must be a registered voter in the city of Danville, be able to read and write the English language, law abiding, energetic, resourceful, organized, take direction well and willing to work two (2) days a year. If you enjoy helping people, you would make an excellent judge.

A Judge is required to attend a full training session once every two years (minimum time 4 hours) in order to be certified for a 2-year term in which you're required to work 4 elections. There are also "refresher" classes held before most elections. A stipend of \$120 is paid to judges that have completed the certification class. The stipend is \$90 if training is not completed before service.
