<u>Environmental Health</u>-Health Department is back to fully staffed in Environmental Health. The new food program is working well.

<u>Public Health Emergency Preparedness-</u> As of now just keeping up with CDC quidelines.

<u>Immunizations</u> – The Health Department is short a nurse after Jessica Schuske left.

<u>WIC (Women's, Infants and Children)</u>- The drive up is still how WIC is operating. Brenda Adams was hired as the coordinator and Kimberly Montgomery was hired as the nutritionist.

<u>COVID 19 Contact tracing</u> –The Health Department are fully staffed with Covid Tracers.

<u>COVID 19 Mass Vaccination clinics</u> –In Vermilion County the population of 65 and older is 65% vaccinated. The Health Department will be waiting on more information

about the booster shots. We are trying to figure out new ways to get people vaccinated. The state granted the Health Department with a Crisis Grant and a Covid 19 Grant for Fiscal year 2022.

**Building Renovations** – The floor has been finished.
