Minutes of the April 10, 2024 meeting of the Danville Election Commission

- 1. Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Thomas Mellen at 1:09 p.m.
- 2. Attendance: Present were Chairperson Thomas Mellen, Vice-chair Frank Young, Secretary David Ryan and Executive Director Sandra Delhaye.
- 3. Approval of Agenda: The agenda was approved unanimously on motion of David Ryan, seconded by Frank Young.
- 4. Approval of Minutes: The minutes of the February, 2024 meeting were approved unanimously on motion of Thomas Mellon, seconded by Frank Young.
- 5. Approval of Payables: Payables in the amount of \$4763.04 (including \$1944 to Faulstich printing for sample ballot inserts for the newspaper) were unanimously approved on motion of Frank Young, seconded by David Ryan.
- 6. Voter Registration Numbers/March, 2024: Sandra Delhaye reported active voters in the total amount of 15,185 (an increase of 48) and inactive voters in the amount of 2,747 (a decrease of 114). Ms. Delhaye indicated that she felt the active voter registrations would increase as the general election drew closer.
- 7. Audience comments: None

- 9. Director Comments: Sandy Delhaye discussed the Budget Report and indicated the office was on track in terms of the budget. Ms. Delhaye reminded all commissioners of their obligation to take the Sexual Harassment training; Mr. Ryan indicated his certificate of compliance was on file with the

county in connection with his Merit Commission employment. Ms. Delhaye reported her office was researching a dissonance beW8een the city and county in regard to the Board of review precincts. Finally, Ms. Delhaye stated the office had received complaints from voters about the lack of parking at the Nazarene Church on Vermilion; she stated she was considering moving a precinct or precincts, and instructing Election Judges to leave parking near the entrance to the polling place open.
