Agenda Item 1- Call to Order and Roll Call

Agenda Item 5 – Ordinance RE: Amendment to the Combined Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for the Mental Health Board 708 – Budget Amendment - \$75,000.00

Hoag motioned, second by Butler to approve.

Russell explained this is moving money the OPIOID settlement funds into the Mental Health fund. Since this is an allowed opioid remediation use, this will allow paying the Illinois Recovery Oriented System of Care expenses via the Mental Health Fund.

<u>Agenda Item 6 – Ordinance RE: Amendment to the Combined Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for the Solid Waste Fund – Budget Amendment - \$10,000.00</u>

Fauver explained this is grant money coming in, and grant money going out. This will be used to pay for a consultant to assist with writing the Five-Year Solid Waste Plan.

Fauver explained this is the Local Health Protection Grant. This is grant money coming in, and grant money going out. This will be used for expenses STI equipment, supplies, travel and personnel.

Napier handed out information on a new rabies tag program. This would have a QR code on the tag, thus allowing the owner to allow information for safe return of a missing pet. A fee schedule was also included in the handout. This reflects that Vermilion County fees are lower than all other counties and thus needs adjusted. Conversation ensued on

fees, adoptions and the current dog case. McFadden stated the fee schedule would be added to the next agenda as a voting item. Napier stated that other counties are charging the same for cats and dogs. Chaiman Baughn explained that he and Napier had a meeting with Mayor Williams that went very well. They are working on a new ordinance and a new intergovernmental agreement to revise the fees with the City of Danville.
