REGISTER TO VOTE TODAY

DID YOU KNOW?

- You may now PRE-REGISTER to vote on or after your 16th birthday by visiting your local Secretary of State office or online using the QR code below!
- If you are 17 years old, you can VOTE in a primary election if you will be 18 years old by the following regular election.

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS:

- U.S. Citizen
- Must be 18 by the time of the upcoming Consolidated or General Election (see [Did You Know?](#))
- Must have been a resident of the precinct at least 30 days prior to Election Day
- Two forms of identification with at least one showing your current residence address. E.g. Driver's License, State ID, Utility Bill, Bank Statement, Paycheck or Government Check, Government Document that shows name and address, or ID card from college with piece of mail.

WAYS TO REGISTER:



Online: Register to vote online at <https://ova.elections.il.gov>



In Person: Register to vote in person at your local County Clerk, Board of Election Commissioner's office, Secretary of State, or any other location designated by the election authority. Find the address for your election authority at <https://elections.il.gov>



By Mail: Register to vote by mailing in an application to your election authority's office. Download the paper application at <https://elections.il.gov>
